Old Business:

Noise: If you are flying gas-powered planes please have mufflers in place and only fly north of the flight line. Please avoid using a left hand landing pattern from the east end of the runway as this will often put you south of the grass barrier and too close to the houses. Helicopters are allowed to fly in the designated helicopter hover area and fly in the normal runway area if they are going to be flying in the normal flight pattern.

New Business:

Frequency control: All flyers should have a Frequency control pin and membership card posted on the frequency control board, including people using the new 2.4Ghz radio.

SMAC will be making a donation to the Church of \$150 for the use of their facilities for our winter meetings and backup meeting place if the weather is bad.
